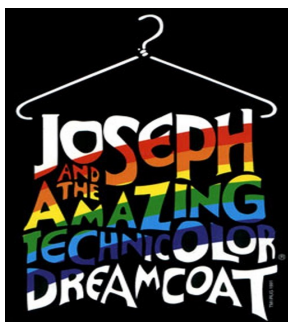

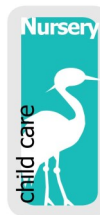
### Welcome!
