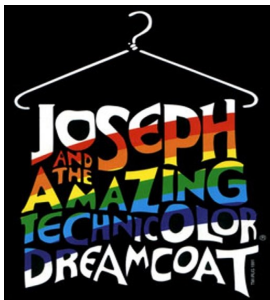

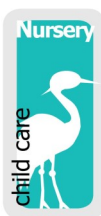
### Welcome to Our Guests
