Welcome to North Broadway!

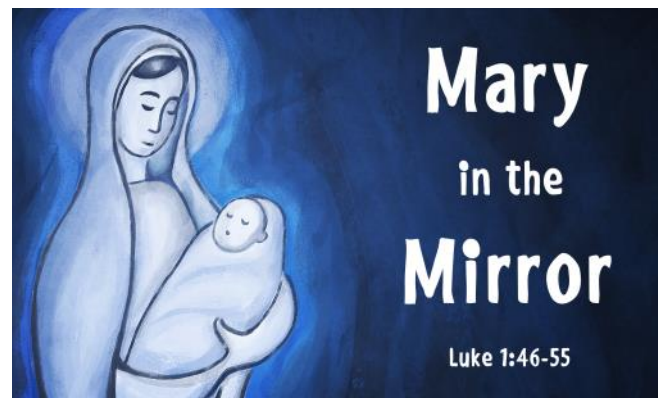
We are glad you chose to join us, and we celebrate your presence!
