### **W6. Communion Preparation**

## **L3. Breakfast—Community Resources Center**

Donate food (purchased or homemade), serve or cook food. Provide hospitality and a hot meal to families and persons on Sunday mornings in December. Team Leader: Kathy Jones

## **L5. YWCA Family Center Team**

## **L6. Adult Volunteers in Mission**

Participate with other adults providing assistance to people in need, both for areas close to the church and in other parts of the country. These trips vary but are typically construction or demolition and are usually during the rebuilding stage of natural disaster recovery. ## **L7. New Life Community Outreach**

Participate in fundraising, correspondence, prayer, and education efforts in support of the Casa de Misericordia (House of Mercy) Orphanage in Piedras Negras, Mexico. They are typically the first to arrive after emergency crews deem the area safe. Their mission is to provide a caring Christian presence and mitigate further damage in the aftermath of a disaster.
